Give Back's YPs 'fuel' success

Local micro-grant funder FUEL Cincinnati has awarded its first grant of 2013 to the group, Foundations: The Cornerstone Inc. The funds will be used for an innovative seven-week workshop in Over-the-Rhine to help 20 girls ages 11-14 map out a path to success.

"Members who have served on the committee for years said this was one of the two or three best applications we've ever received," said FUEL committee chair Joe Stewart-Pirone.

The team at The Cornerstone researched and developed the workshop curriculum and piloted a scaled-down version at a local conference.

Deasa Dorsey, a nurse at the University of Cincinnati Medical Center and a 2010 UC graduate, founded The Cornerstone in 2011 as a community-based nonprofit to improve the lives of young people.

FUEL Cincinnati is an all-volunteer committee of young professionals who provide micro-grants of \$250 to \$2,000 to support nonprofit projects in four core areas: education, community building, diversity and environment. FUEL is part of Give Back Cincinnati, the region's largest young professional volunteer organization.
